ATI FIELD MOPED CONTROL WILD OATS

Controlling wild oats has been a critical issue for many farmers this summer as well. ATI-Teräs has designed a field moped that offers the most effective way to inspect fields and control wild oats.



Moped compared to walking

Inspecting fields with a field moped is pleasant and efficient. Inspecting 100 hectares at 20-metre intervals, for examples, amounts to covering a total distance of 50 kilometres, and this should be done at least twice during the growing season.



Adjustable to any field

The field moped has narrow tyres and sufficient ground clearance to prevent contact with the food grains. The height of the seat is optimised for inspecting the plants. The track width can be adjusted to match the tractor's spray path



Easy to drive

The field moped can be operated at very low speeds to facilitate inspections or at faster speeds to maximise efficiency, depending on the situation.



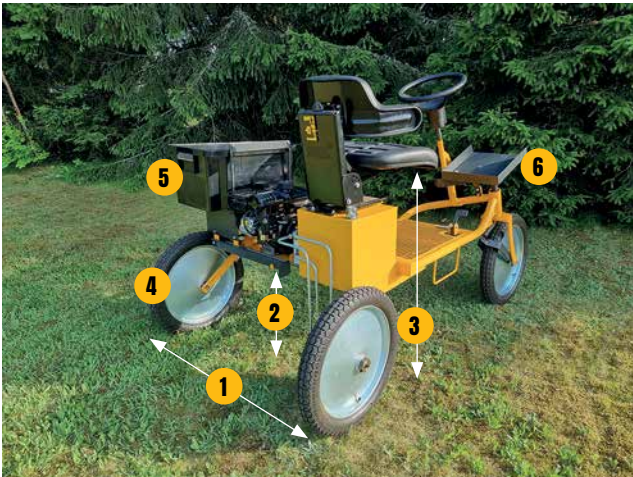
Field moped pays for itself
